

# Turn On Original Sound in Meeting For Zoom Desktop Client

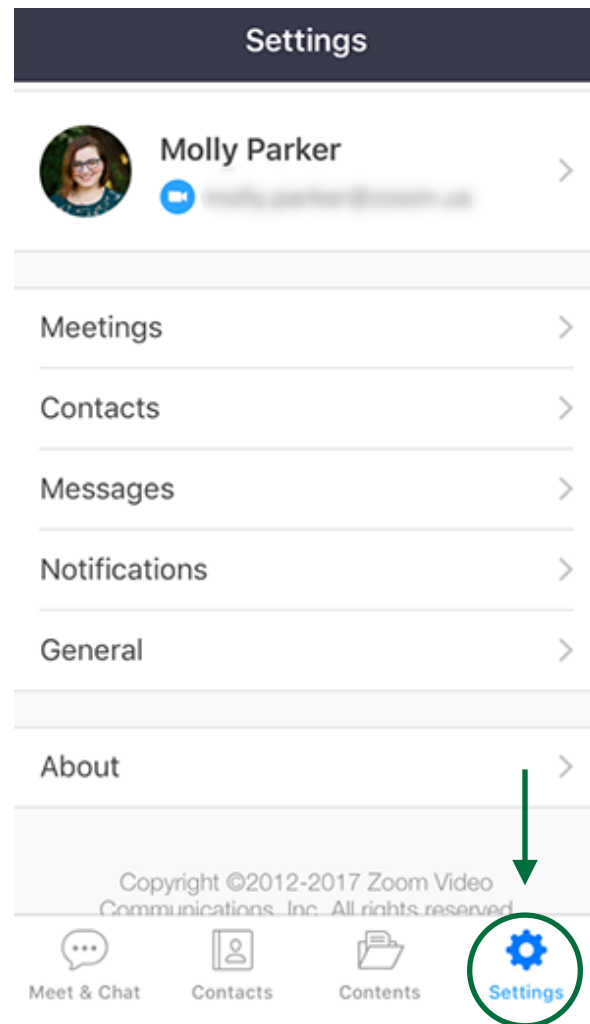
Click the button on the top left corner. When the Original Sound is on, the button should be displayed as “Turn off Original Sound.”



# Enable Original Sound on Mobile Devices or Tablets

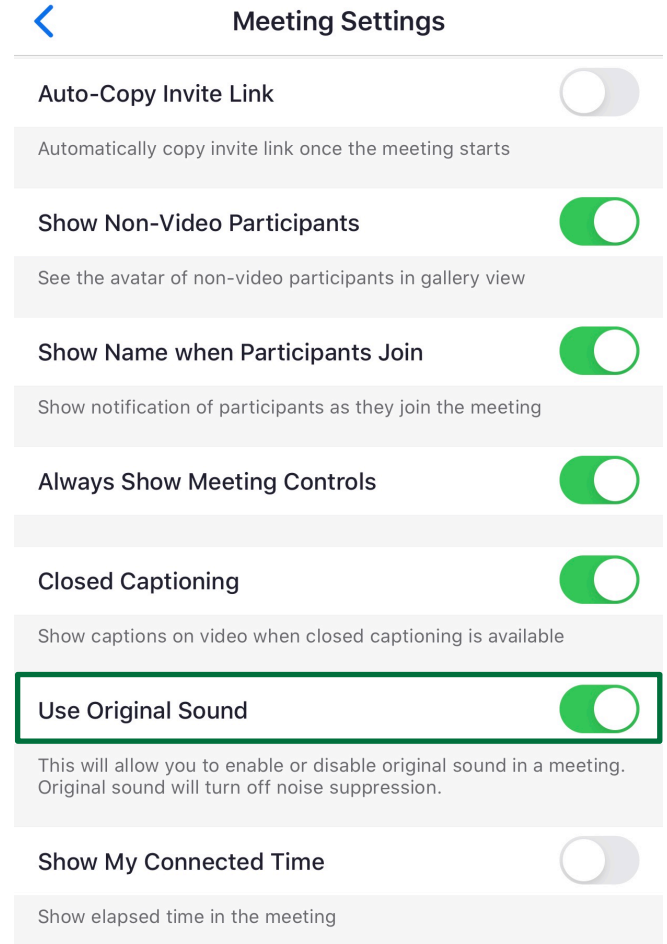
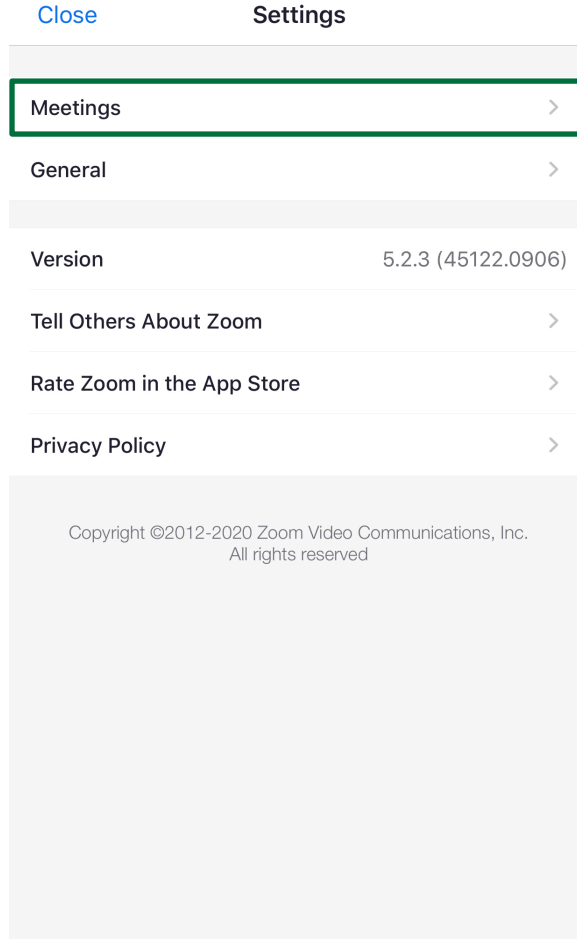
