PIANO VIRTUAL LESSON SETUP



- 1. A designated, distraction-free learning space.
- 2. Practice setting up your camera and testing it BEFORE class begins.
- 3. Please set up the camera on your device so the student's profile and keyboard can be observed. Students can easily transition between looking at the screen or their piano, and I can easier check their position.
- 4. Make sure the environment is well lit.
- 5. Students should sit on a high chair so their elbows are level with the keyboard when they place their hands on the keys. Sitting on a folded blanket is an easy way to raise chair height.
- 6. Students should have their feet on a box/ book so their feet do not dangle in the air.
- 7. If you are using a digital keyboard: make sure students turn their volume on a medium level, with a piano sound.
- 8. A binder for all their music materials within arms' reach. All weekly assignments and tutorials will be made available to you through Dropbox. Prior to class, please check your email for a shared Dropbox link and print the weekly PDF assignments.
- 9. A pencil and highlighter.
